



## Instructions

All young learners, as part of Whole Parish Catechesis, are required to complete a set amount of service hours. For the exact number of hours please consult the Curriculum Guide. These acts of service should incorporate the *Corporal and Spiritual Works of Mercy*. These works may include tasks that are incorporated in the *Households of Faith Kits* or other service your family participates in. You may include service that has occurred from August thru to the last assembly of the year.

This log is to be used to document all events. Please date each, write whether it is a Corporal or Spiritual Work of Mercy and which work it fulfills. Also note the length of time for each Work. Parents should sign or initial each one. Each young learner should have their own log, even if all family members participated in the same service. These logs must be handed in to the lead catechist no later than the last assembly.

*This Service requirement is mandatory.*

### *The Corporal Works of Mercy*

1. Feed the Hungry.
2. Give Drink to the Thirsty.
3. Clothe the Naked.
4. Visit the Imprisoned.
5. Shelter the Homeless.
6. Visit the Sick.
7. Bury the Dead.

### *The Spiritual Works of Mercy*

1. Admonish the Sinner.
2. Instruct the Ignorant.
3. Counsel the Doubtful.
4. Comfort the Sorrowful.
5. Bear Wrongs Patiently.
6. Forgive Injuries.
7. Pray for the Living and the Dead.
